### Classic Cocktails

Cocktails are said to have been invented in America in the early 19th century although there is a record of them being mentioned in writing in England in the late 1700s. The first Cocktail recipe book however was written and published in the USA in the mid 19th century and it is generally accepted that whilst Europe is responsible for a number of cocktail recipes, the majority originate from America.

Below are our versions of some of the tastiest and well known examples.

### Cosmopolitan

It is widely believed that this Cocktail was invented in the USA in the 1970's becoming increasingly popular in the 90's.

We make it with Vodka Citron, Cointreau, cranberry juice and freshly squeezed lime.

### Martini

Originally made with gin but also popular with Vodka. We recommend Tanqueray gin and Belvedere vodka but you can choose any from our extensive list.

Served with olives or a lemon twist.

### Tom Collins

Reportedly first coming to notice in a Mayfair Hotel in London at the very end of the 18th century Tom Collins was included in a Cocktail recipe book published in New York in 1876.

We blend Tanqueray gin, freshly squeezed lemon juice and sugar syrup topped with soda to make this iconic drink.

### Mojito

Rum, fresh mint leaves, brown sugar, lime, ice and a soda-splash.

### Sex on the Beach

A delicious mix of cranberry and orange juice with Vodka and Peach Schnapps.
